Code of conduct:

Mercersburg Academy reserves the right to preserve the experience of the inclusive spirit of the Reunion Weekend program. As a participant in Mercersburg Academy's 2020 Reunion Weekend, you are expected to display good judgment, diplomacy, and courtesy when interacting with each other, friends of Mercersburg, staff, and the community as a whole.

Visitor policy:

The following policies have been established in order to maintain the safety, security, and comfort of all visitors to Mercersburg Academy.

- You must wear your name tag lanyard throughout the weekend. It is your ticket for all meals, alcoholic beverages, and activities, and for safety, your name tag identifies you as a registered reunion guest.
- You will be held responsible for leaving your assigned dormitory room clean and in the condition in which you found it. Mercersburg Academy reserves the right to charge you a fee for any damage done to your assigned room and its contents. You also may be charged a cleaning fee if your room requires professional cleaning in addition to what our staff provides.
- Mercersburg Academy may charge you a fee for any damage you inflict on any part of the campus during your stay.
- You are responsible to remove any items that you bring to campus for the weekend, especially concerning decorations for the class tents on the quad.
- Keys are provided for dorm rooms during Reunion Weekend. Mercersburg recommends that you keep any valuables locked in your room or a vehicle, or that you leave them at home. The school is not responsible for the loss or theft of any valuables or personal belongings during your stay.
- Guests must obtain prior written permission from the school before operating a drone or any other unmanned aircraft system (UAS) on or above the Mercersburg Academy campus or any other Academy property.
- Mercersburg Academy is a tobacco-free, marijuana-free, and drug-free campus. **Smoking and e-cigarette use are not permitted anywhere on campus.**
- Practice reasonable alcohol consumption at all times. Alcohol consumption is not permitted in the hallways of dormitories, and no glass containers are permitted on campus. At events hosted by the school in which alcohol is served, licensed bartenders are required by law to limit

consumption and will do so should you appear to be inebriated. You are fully responsible for any outcome related to any and all cases of over-consumption of any alcohol.

- Please be respectful of the other alumni, faculty members, and children with whom you will be sharing a dormitory. Please keep in mind that many faculty members with young children live on campus year-round in the dorm in which you are a guest, so please be mindful of their space, including parking. Please do not play loud music.
- Children 17 years old or younger are not permitted under tents or at bars without an adult where alcohol is served.
- Campus Safety staff will be monitoring campus all weekend. Please comply with any requests they make of you regarding the policies stated here, as these policies are designed to ensure the safety and comfort of all of our guests and residents on campus. Mercersburg Academy reserves the right to ask visitors who are in violation of campus visitor policies to leave Mercersburg's Reunion Weekend without a refund.
- Mercersburg's 2020 Reunion Weekend ends on Sunday, June 7, at 12 p.m. So that our staff may get to work cleaning and breaking down, we ask that you vacate the dormitories and buildings by no later than 12 p.m.
